FRAGRANCE NOTES: Perfumers chose the language of music to describe the world of scent. Borrowing expressions from this creative outlet, perfume is discussed as having a set of three "notes" that comprise the "chord" or the scent. Like music, perfume's notes unfold over time. The immediate impression of the top or head note soon evaporates into deeper middle or heart notes. The base notes evolve and linger in the final stage, usually 30 minutes after you apply the scent.
